OVERVIEW:

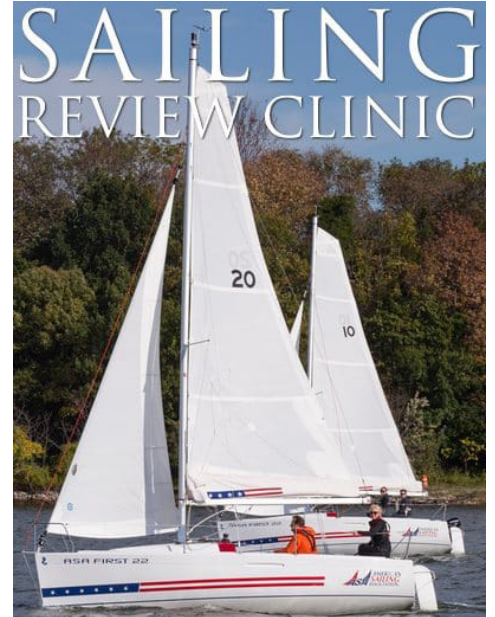
